What am I voting for? The proposed 2022 library budget and the election of one Clifton Park and two Halfmoon Trustees to the Library Board. The Library Board of Trustees is made up of 11 elected representatives, seven from Clifton Park and four from Halfmoon. Trustees serve a five-year term and are elected by each town's residents. There are currently three open trustee positions created by the expiring terms of Jason DiGianni of Clifton Park, and Tom Madison and Russell Wise of Halfmoon.

Where will the voting be held? The vote will take place at the Library, 475 Moe Road, from **7 AM-9 PM on Thursday, September 23** as prescribed by our legislated charter.

Who's eligible to vote? Registered voters, including renters and property owners, in the towns of Clifton Park and Halfmoon who live within the Library District. **Proof of identity is required.**
