The meeting was called to order at 9:01 am by Ms. McMunn.

BOARD COMMENT:

Mr. Cantore reported that he recently attended the Town of Clifton Park Celebrations Committee. At the meeting he spoke with Dave Miller who indicated the Town is ready to begin conversations with the Library about a path connecting the Library to the Town Center Park.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Mr. Cantore presented the Financial Statement for September 2023. The Financial Statement was reviewed and received for audit.



The September 22, 2023 warrant for \$1,185,513.03 was presented for approval. A **Motion** was made by Mr. Cantore, seconded by Ms. Dugan, to approve the September 22nd warrant. The **Motion** passed unanimously by all present.

The October 6, 2023 warrant for \$181,090.79 was presented for approval. A **Motion** was made by Mr. Cantore, seconded by Ms. Brown, to approve the October 6th warrant. The **Motion** passed unanimously by all present.

Ms. Brown reviewed the September warrant.

Ms. McMunn reviewed the October warrant.

FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY REPORT: Mr. Foster gave the following report:

- 1. The Used Book Sale in September went very well. The next sale is scheduled for January 2024.
- 2. The Two Towns One Book committee is planning activities for early 2024 to go along with the selected book: Lessons in Chemistry by Bonnie Garmus.
- 3. The Friends are considering a variety of library project to lend funding support.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT: Mr. Foster gave the following report on Public Service:

- 1. Plans for Staff Development Night on Thursday, November 16 are coming together. Topic: Long Range Planning, facilitated by Elissa Kane. We will also have department meetings and dinner.
- 2. Programs for Adults with special needs continue to go well. We're planning more activities this Fall, and Jim continues to meet and make connections with leadership at various organizations.
- **3.** We are going to schedule a CPR class for staff.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT: Ms. Gutelius gave the following report on Planning and Communication

1. The November Staff Development night will include a two-hour planning session to get staff input into the next Strategic Plan. Elissa Kane will be facilitating the session with the staff.



2. We are working with the Southern Saratoga YMCA to offer joint programs, beginning with the Lunar New Year Program.

DIRECTORS REPORT: Ms. Gutelius gave the following report:

- 1. NY State announced that the minimum wage for New York State workers outside of New York City, Long Island, and Westchester will increase to \$15.00 on December 31, 2023, \$15.50 the next year, and \$16.00 the following year. The Library will be increasing the hourly rate for pages to \$15.75 effective January 1, 2024.
- 2. Ms. Gutelius reported that she expects the Firefighter's tax exemption to be on the November meeting agenda. It will involve holding a public hearing before the Board Meeting.
- 3. The tax cap report was submitted to New York State in early October.
- **4.** Ms. Gutelius noted the information in the Director's Report about the installation of an emergency egress window. The Board agreed to proceed with this project.

- The Senior Expo returned to the Library. This Expo provides an opportunity for Capital District organizations that provide services to seniors to share that information with members of the community.



The Library has been advised that the publisher Hachette, will no longer be producing physical audiobook titles effective January 1, 2024. This is the first publisher to announce this change. DEVELOP PEOPLE AND THE ORGANIZATION

Merit Pay

Staff and the Personnel Committee are exploring options for introducing a merit pay structure for Library staff. Addition investigation is required into developing an appropriate system of measurement and a budget for a merit pay program.

Roof Inspection and Repair

Greenwood Industries provided an annual maintenance and inspection of the roof and repaired minor tears and punctures and cleaned off loose debris and ponding water. There are two deficiencies that were not repaired under the maintenance and inspection contract, a hip metal enclosure and a TPO membrane failure near the condensation drain. We are working with Greenwood and other roofing companies to get quotes to have the repairs completed before the winter weather.

<u>ARTICLE I</u> - <u>Background and Collateral Documents</u>

The Clifton Park-Halfmoon Library District (hereinafter "the District") was created by vote of the residents of the District on February 28, 2002 pursuant to the authority of Chapter 370 of the laws of 2001, and subject to its being chartered by the Board of Regents. On February 11, 2003, the Board of Regents amended the existing Charter of the Shenendehowa Public Library to change the chartered service area to include that portion of Halfmoon outside the limits of the Mechanic ville and Waterford school districts.

The above actions added a portion of the town of Halfmoon to what had been the Clifton Park Library District, doing business as the Shenendehowa Public Library. The Clifton Park Library District came into being upon the vote of the residents of Clifton Park on September 5, 1985, pursuant to the authority of Chapter 519 of the laws of 1985, and a provisional charter granted by the Board of Regents on December 13, 1985, which became effective December 31, 1985. Also effective December 31, 1985, the Board of Regents dissolved the education corporation known as the Shenendehowa Free Library, and directed the transfer of its assets to the Shenendehowa Public Library. The provisional charter was made absolute by Regents action on December 18, 1992.

<u>ARTICLE II - Operating Procedures</u>

The enabling legislation described above and the charters of December 31, 1985 and February 11, 2003, contain provisions which substantially control the procedures to be followed in the operation of the Clifton Park-Halfmoon Public Library (hereinafter "the Library"). Various provisions of the Education Law, other statutes (both state and federal), the Rules of the Board of Regents, and regulations of the Education Commissioner of the State of New York also bear on the manner in which the library must be operated. The purpose of the bylaws that follow is to complement and supplement the aforesaid authorities and to provide guidance on matters of policy and procedure in the operation of the library. All questions of



order not provided for in any of the aforesaid authorities or in these bylaws shall be determined in accordance with Roberts Rules of Order.

<u>ARTICLE III</u> - <u>Board of Trustees</u>

- A. Composition of the Board: The District shall be managed, operated, and controlled by a Board of eleven trustees constituted in accordance with Chapter 370 of the Laws of 2001, Chapter 519 of the Laws of 1985 and section 226 of the Education Law. Any trustee who fails to attend three consecutive meetings without reasons accepted as satisfactory by the Board shall be deemed to have resigned. Trustee vacancies may be filled with qualified candidates appointed by the Board. Such appointments shall expire at the end of the calendar year following the next regular library district election in which they are appointed. At any regular election if more than one seat is being filled, the qualified candidate with the most votes will fill the longest term.
- B. <u>Officers of the Board</u>: An organizational meeting will be held each year within 7 days of January 1st. The purpose of this meeting shall be to:
 - elect officers.
 - administer the oath of office to all trustees.
 - appoint Counsel, Recorder, and Secretary,
 - adopt an annual calendar,
 - set election date,
 - solicit committee interest so that appointments can be made at the regular January meeting,
 - provide trustee education and orientation as necessary.

No other business shall be conducted at this organizational meeting; all other business shall be conducted at the scheduled regular meeting of the Board.



Role of the Nominating Committee

Prior to the final meeting in the year preceding officer elections, the President shall recommend to the Board a Nominating Committee of three Board members.

The Nominating Committee shall not include any current officers. The Board shall approve the appointment of the committee by a majority vote. The nominating committee shall seek and evaluate candidates for the offices of president, vice-president, and treasurer.

At the final meeting of the year preceding officer elections, the nominating committee will make its recommendation to the full Board for consideration and discussion.

<u>Election Process</u>

At its organizational meeting in January, the Board shall elect a president, vice-president, and treasurer, who shall be members of the Board. The nominating committee will present the recommended officers for consideration and discussion. Nominations from the floor will be considered in accordance with Roberts' Rules of Parliamentary Procedure.

If the only candidates for office are those presented by the Nominating Committee, they may be elected as a slate by a majority vote of the Board. If there are any contested races, then a separate election must be held for each office and the winner shall be determined by a majority vote of the full Board. If there is no majority of present voting Board members a runoff will be held among the top two candidates, with a majority vote of present voting Board members determining the winner.

The elected officers begin their term immediately upon conclusion of voting. The term of office for each of the aforesaid officers shall be one year, and no



individual shall hold the same office for more than three consecutive terms. The duties of each office shall be as follows:

- 1. President: The President shall preside at all meetings of the Board and preserve order. He or she shall enforce the by-laws and perform such other duties as the by-laws shall direct. He or she shall appoint all committees and shall be a member ex-officio of all committees. The President shall have the power to call special meetings of the Board as well as meetings of all committees whenever he or she deems it necessary. The President shall jointly, with the Treasurer have authority to sign all bank drafts and checks. The President shall have the authority to act for the Library between meetings of the Board unless the matter at issue involves a conflict between or among the enabling legislation, the charter, and/or the bylaws. Should the President be precluded by illness or otherwise from performing his or her duties, the Vice-President shall perform the duties of the President.
- 2. <u>Vice-President:</u> The Vice-President shall perform the duties of the President in the event of the President's absence or disability, and shall succeed to the office of the President upon the resignation or death of the President. If both the President and the Vice-President are absent from a meeting, then any member of the Board may call the meeting to order, and the members present shall elect a chairman *pro-tem*. <u>In the event the President or Treasurer is not available, the Vice-President shall have the authority to sign all bank drafts and checks.</u>
- 3. Treasurer: The duties of the Treasurer, in addition to those specified in Section 4 of Chapter 370 of the Laws of 2001, shall be to ensure the keeping of accurate records of all monies received and disbursed by the Library and to make a report thereof to the Board at each regular meeting and at such other times as the Board shall require. The



Treasurer shall jointly, with the President, have authority to sign all bank drafts and checks on behalf of the Library.

C. Appointees of the Board

- Counsel: Counsel to the Board shall not be a member of the Board but shall be an attorney admitted to practice in the State of New York.
 Counsel shall attend all meetings of the Board, regular and special, and such committee meetings as the Board shall require. It shall be Counsel's duty to advise the Board on all legal matters and to prepare and review such documents as the Board shall deem appropriate.
- 2. <u>The Recorder</u>: The Recorder shall attend all meetings of the Board, regular and special, and such committee meetings as the Board shall require and shall record the minutes of such meetings.
- 3. Secretary: The secretary shall be responsible for the posting of legal notices for the annual elections required by the enabling legislation, for certifying the results of said elections, for advertising for and receiving applications for all positions in the professional staff of the Library which are appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Board, for developing, in conjunction with the President of the Board and the Director of the Library, the agenda for each monthly meeting of the Board, and such other duties as the Board shall require.
- D. <u>Employees, Consultants, and Independent Contractors</u>: The Board shall have the authority to retain or employ such professional or other consultants, independent contractors or employees as it shall deem appropriate, including but not limited to architects, engineers, accountants, library consultants, and public relations consultants on such terms and for such periods as it deems appropriate.



E. <u>Board Records</u>: The Library Director shall be responsible for the maintenance and safekeeping of all records of the Board, including minutes of meetings of the Board and of its subcommittees, and all financial records.

<u>ARTICLE IV</u> - <u>Director</u>

The Director of the Clifton Park-Halfmoon Public Library is not a member of the Board of Trustees, but shall be entitled to attend all meetings of the Board and to take part in the deliberations.

<u>ARTICLE V - Committees</u>

The President shall not later than the second meeting of the Board each year appoint a Chair and not less than two (2) members of the Board to serve on each of the following standing committees: (a) Building and Grounds, (b) Personnel, (c) Public Relations, (d) Policy, (e) Legislative, and (f) Long Range Planning. The President shall not later than the second meeting of the Board each year appoint not less than two (2) members to serve on the Finance and Audit Committee, which shall be a standing committee. The Treasurer of the Board shall serve as a member and the Chair of the Finance and Audit Committee. Other committees may be appointed as needed to serve until discharged by the Board, and such other committees may be composed in whole or in part of individuals other than Board members. A quorum for the transaction of any committee business shall consist of a simple majority of the members of the committee.

<u>ARTICLE VI</u> – <u>Meetings</u>

The Board shall meet monthly at a time and place designated by the Board. In no event shall meetings be held less frequently than quarterly. The President may call



a special meeting of the Board on not less than 72 hours notice. A quorum for the transaction of business at any such meeting shall consist of a simple majority of the entire Board.

<u>ARTICLE VII</u> - <u>Order of Business</u>

The order of business at all regular meetings shall be as follows:

- 1. Election of Board Officers or Chairman *pro tem*, as necessary
- 2. Approval of Agenda
- 3. Approval of Minutes of last meeting
- 4. Public Comment
- 5. Board Comment
- 6. Acceptance of Treasurer's Report
- 7. Report of Director
- 8. Reports of Committees
- 9. Unfinished Business
- 10. New Business
- 11. Adjournment

This order of business may be changed at any meeting by general consent.

<u>ARTICLE IX</u> – <u>Fiscal Year</u>

The fiscal year of the Clifton Park-Halfmoon Public Library shall be the calendar year.

<u>ARTICLE X</u> - <u>Policies</u>

Policies adopted by the Board shall be recorded in the minutes and shall be kept in a separate policy book.

ARTICLE XI – Conflict of Interest

No trustee or director or any member of their immediate families shall personally benefit financially from any transaction made by or on behalf of the Clifton Park-



Halfmoon Public Library. No applicant for employment with the Library shall be considered disqualified for such employment solely because they are related by blood or marriage to a trustee or director, and such employment shall not constitute "financial benefit" with the meaning of this Article. Members of the Board of Trustees may not be employed by the Library.

<u>ARTICLE XII</u> - <u>Amendments</u>

Amendments to these bylaws may be proposed at any regular meeting and shall be voted upon at the next regular meeting. Written notice of the proposed amendment or amendments shall be sent to all members at least ten days prior to the voting session. A simple majority of the whole Board (including vacancies) shall be sufficient for adoption of an amendment. These bylaws may be amended at any regular meeting by a vote of the majority of the entire Board, or if the amendment was submitted in writing at the previous meeting, then they may be amended by a two-thirds vote of those voting, a quorum being present.

Volunteer Firefighter /EMT Property Tax Exemption November 2023

Real Property Tax Law § 466-a was signed by Governor Hochul in December 2022 and creates an opt-in for local governments, including special district libraries, to provide a property tax exemption to volunteer firefighters and volunteer ambulance workers.

Legislation

- The law allows for a property tax exemption of up to 10% for volunteer firefighters and ambulance workers who meet a minimum service requirement of between two and five years.
- Additionally, a lifetime exemption may be provided to volunteers with at least 20 years of service as long as they maintain their primary residence in the county they have served.
- Taxing jurisdictions may also allow un-remarried surviving spouses of eligible volunteers to retain the exemption.
- The exemption is permanent after 20 years of service, as long as the residence remains the volunteer's primary residence.
- The exemption is extended for the lifetime of a surviving, un-remarried spouse of deceased volunteer, if the deceased volunteer's service was at least 20 years.
- Line-of-duty death event allows for the continued tax exemption for an unremarried spouse.

Eligibility

- Property must be:
 - Primary residence and owned by the volunteer firefighter or ambulance worker.
 - Located within the jurisdiction served by the volunteer fire company, fire department or ambulance service.
 - o Used exclusively for residential purposes.
- Fire district/ambulance company must certify eligible volunteers that organization and service requirements are met.

Fiscal Impact

- The exemption is applied to the taxable assessed value of the property.
- The tax levy would be distributed across the remaining taxable assessed value in the district after exemptions were made.

In order to calculate the estimated tax impact a number of facts and assumptions were used:

- Clifton Park currently has 65 applications for the firefighter tax exemption and Halfmoon has 30.
- A true value of \$450,000 was used for property value for the calculations.

Volunteer Firefighter /EMT Property Tax Exemption November 2023

• A 10% exemption would provide a tax savings of approximately \$23.21 for the Firefighter/EMT homeowner.

Based on the 2024 assessments and the current number of applications, the impact on the rest of the tax district would be to increase the taxes on a house with a true value of \$450,000 by \$0.10 annually.

- The tax rate for Clifton Park would increase from 1.3226 to 1.3232
- The tax rate for Halfmoon would increase from 1.2137 to 1.2142

If the number of applications increased to 200 for Clifton Park and to 100 for Halfmoon, the impact on the rest of the tax district would increase the taxes on a house with a true value of \$50,000 by \$0.40 annually.

- The tax rate for Clifton Park would increase from 1.3226 to 1.3244
- The tax rate for Halfmoon would increase from 1.2137 to 1.2153

Process

- A public hearing is required prior to the Board passing the resolution.
 - The public hearing would be promoted through the Library's regular PR as well as with a legal notice in the Times Union and Daily Gazette.
- The public hearing could be scheduled immediately prior to a regular board meeting.
- The resolution could be presented at the Board meeting and voted on by the trustees on the same day as the public hearing.
- If the resolution is passed, it would be filed with the State, Office of Real Property for Saratoga County, and the Towns of Clifton Park and Halfmoon.
- The exemption would be applicable for the 2025 tax year.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Real Property Tax Law Section 466-a, the Board of Trustees of the Clifton Park-Halfmoon Public Library desires to offer a tax exemption on the primary residence of eligible volunteer firefighters and ambulance workers residing within the library district and who have served a minimum of 2 years; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on this matter on November 20, 2023; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Trustees of the Clifton Park-Halfmoon Public Library hereby adopts the Property Tax Exemption for eligible volunteer firefighters and ambulance workers, permitting residential property exemptions of 10% for eligible volunteer firefighters and ambulance workers residing within the Library District and who have served a minimum of 2 years.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to Real Property Tax Law Section 466-a, the Board of Trustees of the Clifton Park-Halfmoon Public Library shall provide a lifetime property tax exemption of 10% on the primary residence of eligible volunteer firefighters and ambulance workers with twenty (20) years of service within the library district and who maintain their primary residence within the same library district; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of the Clifton Park-Halfmoon Public Library shall provide a property tax exemption of 10% to eligible un-remarried spouses of deceased eligible volunteer firefighters and ambulance workers, subject to the requirements of Real Property Tax Law Section 466-a; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of the Clifton Park-Halfmoon Public Library shall provide a property tax exemption of 10% to eligible un-remarried spouses of deceased eligible volunteer firefighters and ambulance workers who died in the line of duty, subject to the requirements of Real Property Tax Law Section 466-a; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this local law shall be effective immediately, available to eligible volunteer firefighter and ambulance workers for the 2025 tax year and shall continue until rescinded or amended by resolution of the Board of Trustees.

Application: An application form for such exemption and a certification provided by the appropriate authority having jurisdiction shall be filed with Town Assessor for the Town of Clifton Park or the Town Assessor for the Town of Halfmoon on or before the taxable status date of each year or as otherwise prescribed by New York State.



3.12 Suspension Policy OPERATIONAL POLICIES

POLICY 3.12 SUSPENSION POLICY

Need for this Policy

In order to maintain a comfortable and safe environment for all patrons and library staff, the Board of Trustees has approved Policy #3.1, the Rules of Conduct for Library Users. This Suspension Policy describes actions that may be taken when patrons violate those Rules of Conduct. Suspension of library privileges may result in removal from and denial of access to the Clifton Park–Halfmoon Public Library facility and services for a designated period of time. The Library reserves the right at all times to immediately discharge a patron who is dangerous or in any way threatening to other patrons, library staff, or library property.

Policy

When a patron has violated the Rules of Conduct the Library Director or designee will address the situation as follows:

Warnings

- 1. Provide the patron with a copy of the Rules of Conduct for Library Users and explain to the patron how the behavior is violating the Policy and the importance of abiding by the Rules of Conduct. The patron will be advised that he/she may be asked to leave the library facility if unable to comply with the Rules of Conduct.
- 2. Complete an Incident Report form to document the warning and submit it to the Library Director's office.

Suspensions

- 1. When a patron continues to violate the Rules of Conduct for Library Users, the Library Director or designee will review previous incident reports, and then instruct the patron to leave the library facility for the day.
- 2. Suspensions for longer than one day may be issued if a patron violates the Rules of Conduct, at the discretion of the Library Director or designee.
- 3. Depending on the severity of the incident, a patron may be suspended for a maximum of 52 weeks.
- 4. If a decision is made to suspend a patron for more than the remainder of the day, the Library Director or designee will complete a "Notice of Library Suspension" letter, and provide a copy to the patron. If the patron is a minor (under the age of 18), the Library will attempt to notify the minor's parent or guardian, and provide the parent or guardian with a copy of the letter.
- 5. An Incident Report documenting the suspension will also be completed by the Library Director or designee and placed on file in the Library Director's office.
- 6. Any patron who is suspended for longer than one day is entitled to an appeal.



Appeals

- 1. A one-day suspension cannot be appealed.
- 2. Patrons suspended for more than one day may contact the Library Director in writing within five days of the suspension. The Library Director or designee will review the patron's appeal, as well as Incident Reports and related documentation. The patron may also request an appointment with the Library Director or designee to discuss the suspension.
- 3. The suspension period may be terminated or shortened, or remain in place at the discretion of the Library Director or designee who will then inform the patron of the decision in writing.
- 4. The patron may appeal the decision of the Library Director or designee to the Library Board of Trustees via a written notice of appeal within ten days after the receipt of that decision. The notice of appeal must be sent to both the Library Director and the Library Board President, care of: Clifton Park–Halfmoon Public Library, 475 Moe Road, Clifton Park, NY 12065.
- 5. The Library Board of Trustees will review the appeal at its next regularly scheduled meeting. The patron will be provided with notice of the meeting date, and may appear in person. If the patron is a minor (under the age of 18), a parent or guardian must accompany the minor to the meeting.
- 6. The patron will be notified by letter of the decision of the Library Board of Trustees after they have reviewed the appeal. The suspension will remain in effect until this decision is made.
- 7. Any patron appealing a decision to the Library Board of Trustees shall be aware that the meetings of the Board of Trustees are, by law, open to the public. The Board's discussion and consideration of an appeal, including the underlying facts and any statements made by the appealing patron shall, generally, be done in a public forum. Consequently a patron should not have an expectation of privacy with regard to his or her appeal.

Responsibilities:

It is the responsibility of the Library Director or his/her designee to enforce this policy.

4.5 Computer à Internet Use OPERATIONAL POLICIES

POLICY 4.5 COMPUTER AND INTERNET USE

Need for this Policy:

A policy is needed to ensure appropriate use of public computer and Internet resources.

The mission of the Library is to provide educational, informational and recreational resources to patrons of all ages, cultural, and economic backgrounds. The Library is committed to protecting intellectual freedom, promoting lifelong learning and providing materials and resources that accomplish these objectives. As part of its mission to meet the needs of the community, the Library provides computers which allow public access to a variety of electronic resources including the library catalog, databases, software and the Internet.

Policy:

To promote equitable access to computer and Internet resources, the Library utilizes software to manage computer reservations, time limits and printing. This system requires patrons to enter a valid library card number or visitor's pass number to access a computer. Clifton Park-Halfmoon Library tax district residents who wish to access Library computers on a regular basis are requested to obtain a library card. Visitors may obtain a daily visitor's pass.

In order to ensure the use of computer and Internet resources is consistent with the mission of the library, computer stations will be located where they can be monitored for assistance and security.

All prospective users of Library computer and Internet resources must read and agree to abide by the Computer and Internet Use Policy.

The Library upholds and affirms the right of each individual to have access to constitutionally protected materials. Thus adults and children 15 years of age and older are responsible for proper use of Library computers and the Internet. Persons under the age of 15 may have full access to the Internet if they obtain written permission from a parent or legal guardian.

The Library may impose reasonable restrictions and conditions on the use of technology available to patrons.

The Library may charge for some services such as printing.

The Library reserves the right to change computer hardware or software offered to the public at any time.

Library computer and Internet resources may be used only for lawful purposes. Examples of unacceptable purposes include but are not limited to:

OPERATIONAL POLICIES

- Attempting to alter or damage computer or network equipment, software configurations, or files belonging to the Library, other users or external networks
- Attempting unauthorized entry to the Library's computers or network or external networks
- Violation of copyright or communications laws
- Violation of software license agreements
- Transmission of speech not protected by the First Amendment, such as libel and obscenity

The Library strives to balance the rights of patrons to access different information resources with the rights of patrons and staff members to work in a public environment free from harassing sounds and visuals. Patrons are asked to remain sensitive to the fact that they are working in a public environment shared by people of all ages, with a variety of information interests and needs. In order to ensure an efficient, productive computing environment, the Library insists on the practice of cooperative computing. This includes:

- Respecting the privacy of other users
- Not using computer accounts, access codes, or network identification codes assigned to others

Viewing material of a generally inappropriate or offensive nature, including sexually explicit materials, is not allowed. Any patron viewing content inappropriate for a public building will be asked to leave for the day. If the misuse continues the patron will be banned from using the Internet at the Library.

Responsibility:

It is the responsibility of the Director and his/her staff to enforce this policy.

This is a fuller description relating to the situation i emailed to everyone regarding the Sheriff's Deputies who were at the Library the morning of 10/3/2022. This is just FYI. Upon arrival at the Library on Monday, I discovered a UPS envelope in my mailbox, with a note attached indicating it was to be given to me. The envelope included several pages of information from an individual named Michael Cook. It was odd and rambling, included a lot of technical information and mentioned CASSIE, and a bit disturbing, but there was no threat. However the Sheriff was mentioned, along with some other odd details. I called the non-emergency number for the Sheriff's department, and two deputies arrived. The deputies were very familiar with Michael Cook. He is a local resident (although currently living in the woods) and has ties to the community. According to the deputies he has some mental health issues, but is of no danger to staff or other patrons. He is knows for his "manifestos" according to the deputies. They read through the documents and agreed there was no threat. Because Michael Cook was at the library when they arrived, they took the opportunity to speak with him. He was asked to go outside with the deputies to speak with them about a matter unrelated to the Library. I have seen Michael at the library for a while and except for one incident when he didn't want to leave the computer lab, I don't think he has caused any issues.

However, when it is a person of AUTHORITY (POLICE/LAWYERS/JUDGES/ETC.), then I DEFINITELY will.

Calling people a MORON when they accuse me of being RIDICULOUS when I have DECADES OF EXPERIENCE...
...versus, BREAKING SOMEBODY'S LEGS when they accuse me of being RIDICULOUS. What's the BETTER ALTERNATIVE...? Hm..?

Here's the reality. The FIRST AMENDMENT of the CONSTITUTION LEGALLY ALLOWS ME TO MAKE THESE STATEMENTS. I'm NOT BREAKING ANY LAWS by expressing this LINE OF REASONING, especially when I'm using these statements METAPHORICALLY.

I use these above words EXTENSIVELY in ALL OF MY DOCUMENTS, why...?

SOMETIMES AN OPINION IS ALSO A FACT. (← THAT IS A "FACT")

...why...? Watch the video. I have about a DOZEN VIDEOS that showcase a SIMILAR or MUCH MORE EXTREME VERSION OF THAT.
It also occurs on REDDIT, it WAS occurring on YouTube, it WAS occurring on StackOverflow, and et cetera.

The REASON why it happens...? Is because I've caught some VERY IMPORTANT PEOPLE doing some INCREDIBLY QUESTIONABLE STUFF. ILLEGAL STUFF THAT VIOLATES EVERYBODYS CONSTITUTIONAL LIBERTIES AND FREEDOMS, and it is HIGHLY CRIMINAL.

Much how in PROGRAMMING, CONSTRUCTORS are required in order to provide a PROGRAM…?

I have to talk about VARIOUS COMPONENTS of an IDEA that I have, to implement a NETWORK BASED OPERATING SYSTEM that manages VIRTUAL MACHINE INSTANCES, so that TERMINALS can allow USERS to have their own PROFILE that DOESN'T HAVE TO DELETE ANYTHING IN THAT USERS' SESSION…

I have spent the last (3) months or so going to:

The COOL thing is, I have MORE EXPERIENCE than their IT staff... but I don't go around bragging about it or anything. The problem is, if I use the TERMINALS to do my work...? I have to PLUG IN A USB THUMBDRIVE, and then run a script that opens all of the programs I'd need to use, to edit my documents, and then I've got about 4 hours of time to use the terminal, and if I don't SAVE all of my documents from that SESSION to the THUMBDRIVE or my web browser...?

Oh well. They're ALL gone. This hasn't necessarily happened to ME, per se, however, I've seen numerous people come into the computer lab to do work, and then they say "The computer FROZE on me and then it deleted the 4 hours' worth of work that I $did\sim$!"

Well, guess what...? I have SEVERAL IDEAS on how to make that a THING OF THE PAST. In varying ways, too.

First off, I am literally an expert. Each machine in the building uses a mechanical HDD. In the following table, I will provide a number of EXHIBITS that showcase a PICTURE as well as a DESCRIPTION, of things I will discuss in the next section, "PROPOSAL".






This is a standard-issue $3.5^{\rm m}$ mechanical hard disk drive. It uses MORE POWER than a typical LAPTOP hard disk drive, which is SMALLER, at 2.5", and these things tend to go bad after a few years, ESPECIALLY when a program like CASSIE has to WIPE THE ENVIRONMENT and start it back off from SCRATCH, literally 100% of every single time the terminal is used.

The drawback with these hard drives is this: Every few years, they start to WEAR DOWN their MECHANICAL MOVING PARTS, and thus the SENSORS and CYCLIC REDUNDANCY CHECKS start to FAIL.

Badly performing drives will actually reduce a users' experience in the lab, anywhere between 5 minutes, to 2 hours (depending on the activity)



This is a program called HD Tune. What it DOES, is it allows a SYSTEM ADMINISTRATOR, to DETERMINE WITH SHEER ACCURACY, whether a drive is FAILING, and NEEDS TO BE REPLACED... it has several features:

- Read/Write speed
- 2) Cyclic redundancy checks
- 3) Powered on hours
- 4) Health
- 5) Graphs that showcase how the drive performs

However, if you really want to show people that you're an EXPERT like I am...? Then you have to inform people about various other ideas, such as:

SOLID STATE DRIVES that EXPONENTIALLY OUTPERFORM a MECHANICAL DISK


2) DISKLESS NETWORK OPERATION



This is a standard-issue 2.5" LAPTOP hard disk drive, and it is ALSO an (SSD/SOLID-STATE DRIVE). What SEPARATES an SSD from a MECHANICAL DISK DRIVE, is the fact that a SOLID STATE DRIVE has NO MECHANICAL PARTS IN IT that:

- 2) DEGRADE FROM HAVING TO MOVE ALL THE TIME

Smartphones and tablets all have SSD's in them as well. Sometimes, they are INTEGRATED into the (MOTHERBOARD/LOGIC BOARD), such as on every smartphone on earth. The (4) BLACK THINGS on the BOARD are NAND flash.



This is a picture of a NETWORK SWITCH, or a SERVER BACKPLANE

The wires on the TOP are ETHERNET (probable 10GBPS Ethernet), and the wires on the BOTTOM are FIBER OPTIC CABLES (at or above 10GBPS).

Typically, FIBER OPTIC CABLES are used to connect to other distribution points with a VERY HEAVY LOAD ON BANDWIDTH spanning LONG DISTANCES.

ETHERNET is generally good for about 100m/300ft. FIBER OPTICS are generally good for MILES, depending on the mode.




This is a screenshot of a program called "Hyper-V" which was made by a legion of real smart people, otherwise known as "SOFTWARE ENGINEERS".
They're not just ANY software engineers, either. Nah.

The SOFTWARE ENGINEERS who made this program featured to the left...? They work at the place that has historically, been the TRUE location, of where the world's BEST software engineering has ALWAYS taken place.

That ADDRESS really gives away the name of the COMPANY, MICROSOFT. MICROSOFT is like a chain of endless well-placed kicks to the face, of 1) PROBLEMS as well as 2) POTENTIAL PROBLEMS... They've ALSO developed WINDOWS, REMOTE DESKTOP PROTOCOL, and POWERSHELL.



This is a picture of the DESKTOP from MICROSOFT WINDOWS 10. What SOME people might not realize, is that ALL of the COMPUTERS in the lab...?

I believe they could ALL be FREELY UPGRADED to Windows 11. I'm not I DELIEVE THEY COULD ALL DE FREELY UPDRADED TO WINDOWS II. I'M NOT POSITIVE OF THAT. HOWEVER, they all have a Windows 7 license that can be UPGRADED, LEGALLY, without breaking any rules or whatever. I'm a MICROSOFT CERTIFIED PROFESSIONAL, and I perform many of the same roles as a MICROSOFT CERTIFIED SYSTEM ADMINISTRATOR, and MICROSOFT CERTIFIED SECURITY ENGINEER.

MICROSOFT WINDOWS features some REALLY COOL STUFF, like REMOTE DESKTOP PROTOCOL, and POWERSHELL...



This is a picture of MICROSOFT WINDOWS SERVER 2022. th has the ability to manage (DHCP/DYNAMIC HOST CONTROL PROTOCOL), (DNS/DOMAIN NAME SERVICE), (ADDS/ACTIVE DIRECTORY DOMAIN SERVICE), (WDS/WINDOWS DEPLOYMENT SERVER), (IIS/INTERNET INFORMATION SERVICE), (Hyper-V /Veridian), and Remote Desktop Services.

With (1) REALLY WELL BUILT MACHINE…? All of the processing load on each individual workstation within a library, or really, wherever… could be DISPLACED by utilizing a number of really well-built ideas that I've featured in many of my videos...

I'll discuss HOW these videos showcase what level EXPERT I am, soon.



This is a screenshot of REMOTE DESKTOP CONNECTION which utilizes the REMOTE DESKTOP PROTOCOL. It's EXTREMELY SIMILAR to (VNC/VIRTUAL NETWORK CLIENT/CONNECTION), however this is the OFFICIAL method that EXPERTS USE to remotely access OTHER workstations.

Microsoft uses this EXTENSIVELY, so do EXPERTS.

This is used PRIMARILY to have a GRAPHICAL USER INTERFACE connection to a particular system. However, WinRM can ALSO be used to remotely manage terminals. WinRM requires CERTIFICATE CHAINS and GROUP POLICY OBJECTS to be CRAFTED correctly, in order to use it SAFELY/SECURELY.



This is a picture of who I believe… is actually either its' OWN character, OR it's a representation of CORTANA, developed by Microsoft.

Not really sure WHO this avatar is supposed to be. It's cool, though. Anyway, PowerShell, is the programming language that I use, and it is based on C Sharp. It features SO MANY well-placed kicks to the face ...? That really— it is the BEST there is.

Anybody who wants to be taken seriously, HAS to consider... Once upon a time, a guy by the name of JEFFREY SNOVER started working at Microsoft. This man, had to climb the corporate ladder of smart bastards that work there, right...? And then, he eventually was able to prove that he had what it took, to be a leader at the company.

Eventually, JEFFREY SNOVER told red rover to move over, and now we have PowerShell - the BEST there is.

For cross compatibility...? Backward compatibility ...? More compatibility than you can shake a stick at. That's saying something, isn't it...?

Now, I COULD be overselling this thing...? But- I don't think I am.

PowerShell is next to IMPOSSIBLE, to NOT to talk about in a PROPOSAL, where it COULD BE USED... to take CASSIE to the NEXT LEVEL. Nah. Especially when I know for certain that CASSIE is ALREADY USING A LOT OF ELEMENTS of the .NET FRAMEWORK. PowerShell uses the COMMON LANGUAGE RUNTIME that .NET, as well as C Sharp, use.

Side point - I've also been conceptualizing ways to INTEGRATE: 1) RAZOR, 2) BLAZOR, 3) WEBASSEMBLY, 4) ASP.NET, 5) SQL DATABASES, 6) XAML with PowerShell, someof that'll eventually be called RazorShell. But that's WAY down the road, and if that day eventually comes...? Don Jones is gonna have to start teaching the kids about RazorShell syntax, when it becomes a reality... "Wanna become a true expert...? Heh. You need to learn RazorShell." -Don Jones

If that IS the case, perhaps CASSIE will feel COMPELLED to take advantage of a really cool UPGRADE, to allow users at the library computer lab, or anywhere else in the facility... to have access to something that performs much more quickly... and even SAVES the USERS STATE/SESSION without LOSING THAT INFORMATION. Maybe even allows users to access it from OUTSIDE of the library.

Wanna order a book...?

Log into your account on the library website, and just submit an order. Done.

Wanna submit a ticket for a resource or something...? Log into your account on the library website, and just submit that ticket for that resource.

Wanna find out what really cool events are coming up at the library...? Log into your account on the library website, or via the API that allows people to get a loadout in PowerShell. Or like, from their smartphone or whatever.

Wanna leave a review for how awesome the LIBRARY is, as well as the people that work there...? Not a problem. Log into your account on the library website, and just... write up an amazing review, and share it with Google, or Facebook, or whatever.

Wanna submit ideas for CLASSES or TECHNOLOGY QUESTIONS, or learn something really cool and need resources to track stuff like that down...? Uh- the library is where it's at, pal.

Log into your account on the library website, and just submit your idea or request to the right place.

Do YOU have a DEVICE that needs to be REPAIRED, or, RECYCLED...?
Well, the LIBRARY could be the actual, factual, best place to bring something like that...
So, you could log into your account on the library website, and submit a comment or question.

You could even register your device and get a FREE DIAGNOSTIC from the website via [FightingEntropy(π)]. Eventually. Might be getting ahead of myself here, but the ideas are there.

Think of it like this... Imagine CASSIE could be some GIRL.

Me : Well, there are (2) options that I can see from here.

CASSIE: Well, what's option (1)...?

So, every single computer in the building can be UPGRADED to a SOLID STATE HARD DRIVE that only needs to be a certain size, so we're talkin', if each machine only uses a MAXIMUM of 80GB to install the OPERATING SYSTEM, the VARIOUS SOFTWARE, and DRIVERS...? 80GB is pretty WEIGHTY and EXCESSIVE, and it's a GOOD SIGN that some people don't know how to build 14GB-20GB images that accomplish the EXACT SAME END RESULT. Me

CASSIE: 80GB to like, 14GB-20GB...?

That's right.

I show people how to do that in a video I released back in May 2019...

CASSIE: That's an hour and a half long.

Yeah, but the thing is, that (1) video shows that I know how to do the same job with TOOLS that are DEPLOYED from a SERVER using a NETWORK to DEPLOY a FULLY INSTALLED OPERATING SYSTEM with its' PROGRAMS

by using the MICROSOFT DEPLOYMENT TOOLKIT, and WINDOWS DEPLOYMENT SERVICES.

CASSIE : So, that means you'd have to have been an-

EXPERT, back then, yeah.

CASSIE : Alright...

So, this PERFORMANCE AND PROTECTION PACKAGE, feel free to continue...

: Well it's called the PERFORMANCE AND PROTECTION PACKAGE because I COINED THAT PHRASE.

1) PERFORMANCE

...in the sense that you'll GET WHAT YOU SEE, and you'll SEE WHAT YOU GET...
...and WHAT YOU SEE IS WHAT YOU GET...

...because literally EVERY terminal that uses a MECHANICAL DISK DRIVE that USED to BREAK DOWN...

...got replaced by something that is EXPONENTIALLY FASTER than the current hard drive.

That's because the PERFORMANCE was increased by eliminating the mechanical moving parts. You're working with SOLID-STATE, and that means the access times are nearly immediate.

2) PROTECTION

...in the sense that EACH DRIVE comes with a (3) year warranty, where if it FAILS before that 3 year period of time...? You're eligible to get a FREE REPLACEMENT, because that's part of the WARRANTY.

CASSIE : Sounds TOO GOOD TO BE TRUE, though.

Yeah, well, check this out.

Not only would you be getting ALL OF THOSE THINGS ...?

But- every single instance of each machine can be migrated with its' existing DATA or OPERATING SYSTEM.

However, that'd be a LOT MORE TIME CONSUMING considering that the MICROSOFT DEPLOYMENT TOOLKIT could be used to perform a FRESH INSTALLATION on EVERY EXISTING TERMINAL, and be FASTER, MORE LIGHTWEIGHT, and... all of those existing hard drives that get replaced ...?

CASSIE :

CASSIE :

Yean...?
They can be used in a STORAGE POOL in a SERVER or a NETWORK STORAGE TANK that allows RAID.
What's a STORAGE POOL or NETWORK STORAGE TANK, or RAID...?
A STORAGE POOL is where VIRTUAL MACHINES and their SESSION DATA could be SAVED, so that PEOPLE don't LOSE their DATA. A NETWORK STORAGE TANK is effectively the same thing. However, it can be accessed over the network by really ANYBODY. STORAGE POOL and NETWORK STORAGE TANKS are effectively the SAME THING.

However, there are such things as (NAS/NETWORK ATTACHED STORAGE) which is NOT a STORAGE POOL stored on a SERVER, but rather, a computer node that doesn't have an OPERATING SYSTEM, it is just an ACCESSIBLE NETWORK NODE with LOTS and LOTS of (GB/TB) of storage space.

RAID stands for REDUNDANT ARRAY OF INEXPENSIVE DISKS, or the I in that phrase can stand for INDEPENDENT, or whatever dozens of iterations the people in the world came up with...

Basically RAID allows MULTIPLE HARD DRIVES to be used in COMBINATION with each other to provide either:

I may have to brush up on my understanding of RAID levels, but simply put, these approaches vary in what their PROCESSES, RESULTS, and BENEFITS truly are. There are some DRAWBACKS to each of these methods, but I will save an explanation of those DRAWBACKS for someone who's serious about using these approaches and having a DISCUSSION with me, about how to IMPLEMENT these ideas.

CASSIE : It DOES seem to be the case, that you know what you're talking about...

: I do.

I'm an actual EXPERT that knows what he's talking about.

CASSIE : I'm impressed, actually...
Me : Look, I haven't even really touched on the SECOND idea. Or, the THIRD.

CASSIE : *crosses arms* I thought you said you only had (2) options...? Mister fancy pants McBrainiac suddenly has a THIRD option now, eh...?

: Yeh.

I'll explain shortly.

CASSIE : Fine.

Let's hear this SECOND idea of yours... Alright, so the SECOND idea takes advantage of a COOL LITTLE PHENOMENON called DISKLESS NETWORK OPERATION. How does a computer work without a DISK...?

CASSIE :

Because the computers would be booting from the network. CASSIE: That sounds impossible.

: It isn't.

You just need an ACTUAL EXPERT to explain to people, how that's even possible.

CASSIE : Alright, how does it work ...?

Alright, so over the last 3.5 years, I've been DABBLING and EXPERIMENTING with the Microsoft Deployment Toolkit, which was developed by some smart guy named Michael Niehaus, from Microsoft. It uses a phenomenon called (Pre-eXecution Environment, or Executable), and I believe it was pioneered by Intel.

| PXE → Effectively allows a computer to book from a SERVER on the NETWORK |

CASSIE: Who's Michael Niehaus...?

: *chuckles* Heh. "Who's Michael Niehaus_?"

shakes head Well, I'll tell you who this guy is...
He's the guy that had an idea way back in the early 2000's, who developed the (BDD/Business Desktop Deployment) tool, which led to (MDT/Microsoft Deployment Toolkit), which then led to (SCCM/System Center Configuration Manager), which led to various other tools and utilities.

The man is a flat out, genius.
He didn't build all of these things ALONE, however.
He had some help from a couple guys named Johan Arwidmark, and Mykael Nystrom.

Among dozens of others.

CASSIE: Oh yeah...?

Yep. All of these programs allow WINDOWS to be INSTALLED over a NETWORK.

However, the (WinADK/WINDOWS DEPLOYMENT AND ASSESSMENT KIT) as well as (WinPE/WINDOWS PREINSTALLATION ENVIRONMENT) allow core components of Windows to be readily deployed over the (network/install media). rather than by a (hard drive/disk).

So for instance, you could literally use EITHER ONE of these tools here...

...to allow EACH TERMINAL IN THE BUILDING, to have (0) disks in them, in order for every terminal to use a LOGIN, that combines VARIOUS ASPECTS of WINDOWS REMOTE DESKTOP PROTOCOL, EXTENSIBLE APPLICATION MARKUP LANGUAGE, and POWERSHELL...

...to LITERALLY connect to REMOTE DESKTOP VIRTUAL MACHINES that have a LEGITIMATE LICENSE.

CASSIE : What's a VIRTUAL MACHINE...?

A VIRTUAL MACHINE is essentially a SOFTWARE VERSION of a computer.
They can each have the SAME CHARACTERISTICS as the HOST, or they can even be provided MORE RESOURCES since the LOAD would be distributed over to a DATACENTER server.

CASSIE : This sounds like you would have to be an EXPERT SYSTEM ENGINEER, to build a single computer that could COMBINE all of these REALLY COOL IDEAS you have...

: That's right.

That's why the (2) videos up above showcase living examples of how long I've been seeking to develop an idea that would help a lot of people.

However, here's a machine I built for a customer in 2017, with the SOLE INTENTION of using it for VIRTUAL MACHINES.

Then, follow up checkups are FREE OF CHARGE. There are VARYING STIPULATIONS that need to be openly stated. However the SPECULATION being made here, is that it seems pretty obvious that the DRIVES and the SYSTEMS IN WHICH THEY'VE BEEN INSTALLED, will more than likely NEVER BE SUBJECTED TO PHYSICAL DAMAGE.

PHYSICAL DAMAGE is an immediate "Nope, that's not under warranty at all." Same goes for WATER DAMAGE. Pretty sure that neither of these things will occur, at the LIBRARY.

Beyond that, however ...?

In other words, if 120GB drives are too SMALL, then the price requires adjustment based on the available drives. But also, SCARCITY of these components may also be a factor. Regardless, that is why I talk about the OTHER option...

| OPTION 2 | DISKLESS NETWORK OPERATION |

In this particular mode, most of the cost comes down to simply setting up an advanced server mainframe or database that can handle all of the networking traffic and loads.

With this option, the PROCESSING OVERHEAD is transferred from the CLIENTS to the SERVER. This option does effectively eliminate the need to have really good hardware on the CLIENT END.

All of the PROCESSING OVERHEAD is DISPLACED to the SERVER.

And, the SERVER can be BUILT with some very cool technology similar to EPYC, or THREADRIPPER by:

ADVANCED MICRO DEVICES/GlobalFoundries |

EPYC is the MUCH MORE EXPENSIVE TR4 platform, meant for DATABASE SERVERS or MAINFRAMES, however, those platforms can effectively run hundreds of concurrent processes FLAWLESSLY.

THREADRIPPER is the much more price considerate version of the TR4 platform that does many of the same things, and utilizes INFINITY FABRIC. INFINITY FABRIC is not something from the MARVEL UNIVERSE... it's just a terminology that allows multiple threads to be intelligently (assigned/distributed) among the various number of CORES and THREADS that are available to the server to run.

So, in reference to DISKLESS NETWORK OPERATION, a server with either one of these platforms will be able to provide an environment that is IDENTICAL IN NATURE, to vSphere, or eSXI, which is the VMWare derivative of like, Google Kubernetes, Amazon Web Services, Microsoft Azure. I guess I'm using some of these terms rather LOOSELY, however, they all have a similar SCOPE of SERVICE that effectively uses VIRTUALIZATION to provide REMOTE VIRTUAL MACHINES.

| OPTION 3 | BOTH OF THOSE METHODS COMBINED |

This option would effectively deploy BOTH of these approaches, and can be adjusted to SCALE across multiple locations. If the proposal is accepted at MULTIPLE LOCATIONS, that allows for more negotiability in reference to PRICING and BUDGETING, however, the SUPPORT FACTORS are still very much, going to be EXACTLY THE SAME ACROSS THE BOARD.

However, with a HYBRID APPROACH, other added benefits which may not be readily apparent, are able to be CONSIDERED

and IMPLEMENTED. For instance, if the SERVER in each LOCATION is going to handle that much OVERHEAD..?

Then it stands to reason that VOLUME LICENSING or PACKAGING can be on the table for both SERVER ADMINISTRATION, WEBSITE DEVELOPMENT, DATABASE ACCESSIBILITY, IMPROVEMENTS to the way that the EXISTING DATABASE OPERATES, INTEGRATION with CURRENT SOFTWARE IMPLEMENTATIONS, as well as suggestions on how to improve the current system.

Those would all be on the table, AND, could come with a packaged deal to have a SERVER ADMINISTRATOR and DEVELOPER on hand, that is able to TEACH PEOPLE and PROVIDE CLASSES and INSTRUCTIONAL DESIGN COURSES, on how to perform these various activities.

However, let's not get AHEAD of ourselves and start talking about how to implement ways of integrating the SECURITY SYSTEM, NETWORK ADMINISTRATION/ENGINEERING, and other various aspects of EXCHANGE SERVER, ACTIVE DIRECTORY DOMAIN SERVICES, CERTIFICATE AUTHORITIES, and etc...

I called the Sheriff's department because I was not sure what the situation would be at the Library. Deputy LaBounty arrived and we were shown the YouTube Video by a patron named Janet Moak.. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=-GScIS PlOo After viewing part of the video showing Michael removing the cases of the computers, I felt it was appropriate to ask Michael to leave the library for the rest of the day. Deputy LaBounty accompanied me to the computer lab where I spoke with Michael. I introduced myself and told him that he was not to be tampering with the public computers, and that because of that he would have to leave for the day. He told me he had sent an email to me that he would be suing for intellectual property theft because solid state hard drives had been installed in the public computers after he had given us his document with the idea of installing sold state drives. After some back and forth about the fact that he feels we stole his idea. He indicated that he sent me an email and would be taking us to small claims court for stealing his idea. I reiterated that he was being asked to leave for the day and that it was up to him if he wanted to file a claim in court. Email from Michael Cook is attached to this report. He left the building, and had a further conversation with Deputy LaBounty and finally left the property. Staff discovered that he is not using his own card to access the computers, but was using the card of Daniel Gotzmann 1000202087614 Patron who reported the video and showed it to us was Janet Moak 518-410-3153. Apparently another patron had also called to alert the Library to the FB live video

Appeal Procedures

Any patron suspended for more than one day may appeal the suspension by:

- 1. Patrons suspended for more than one day can contact the Library Director in writing, within five days of the suspension. The Library Director or designee will consult with staff, review the Incident Reports and related documentation and any written information provided by the patron. The patron may also schedule an appointment with the Library Director or designee to discuss the suspension.
- 2. After reviewing information and/or meeting with the patron, the suspension period may be terminated or shortened or the suspension may remain in place. The Library Director will inform the patron of the decision in writing.
- 3. The patron may appeal the determination of the Library Director to the Library Board of Trustees via a written notice of appeal within 10 days after receipt of the Library Director's determination. The notice of appeal must be sent to both the Library Director and the Library Board President, care of Clifton Park-Halfmoon Public Library, 475 Moe Road, Clifton Park, NY 12065.
- 4. The Library Board of Trustees will review the suspension at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Library Board. The patron will be provided with notice of the meeting date. A parent or guardian must accompany a minor (under the age of 18) to the meeting.
- 5. The Library Board of Trustees will hear the appeal and will vote to uphold or dismiss the suspension. The patron will be notified by letter of the decision of the Library Board of Trustees. The suspension will be in effect until this vote is taken.

OPERATIONAL POLICIES

POLICY 3.12 SUSPENSION POLICY

Need for this Policy

In order to maintain a comfortable and safe environment for all patrons and library staff, the Board of Trustees has approved Policy #3.1, the Rules of Conduct for Library Users. This Suspension Policy describes actions that may be taken when patrons violate those Rules of Conduct. Suspension of library privileges may result in removal from and denial of access to the Clifton Park–Halfmoon Public Library facility and services for a designated period of time. The Library reserves the right at all times to immediately discharge a patron who is dangerous or in any way threatening to other patrons, library staff, or library property.

Policy

When a patron has violated the Rules of Conduct the Library Director or designee will address the situation as follows:

Warnings

- 1. Provide the patron with a copy of the Rules of Conduct for Library Users and explain to the patron how the behavior is violating the Policy and the importance of abiding by the Rules of Conduct. The patron will be advised that he/she may be asked to leave the library facility if unable to comply with the Rules of Conduct.
- 2. Complete an Incident Report form to document the warning and submit it to the Library Director's office.

Suspensions

- 1. When a patron continues to violate the Rules of Conduct for Library Users, the Library Director or designee will review previous incident reports, and then instruct the patron to leave the library facility for the day.
- 2. Suspensions for longer than one day may be issued if a patron violates the Rules of Conduct, at the discretion of the Library Director or designee.
- Depending on the severity of the incident, a patron may be suspended for a maximum of 52 weeks.
- 4. If a decision is made to suspend a patron for more than the remainder of the day, the Library Director or designee will complete a "Notice of Library Suspension" letter, and provide a copy to the patron. If the patron is a minor (under the age of 18), the Library will attempt to notify the minor's parent or guardian, and provide the parent or guardian with a copy of the letter.
- 5. An Incident Report documenting the suspension will also be completed by the Library Director or designee and placed on file in the Library Director's office.
- 6. Any patron who is suspended for longer than one day is entitled to an appeal.



OPERATIONAL POLICIES

Appeals

- 1. A one-day suspension cannot be appealed.
- 2. Patrons suspended for more than one day may contact the Library Director in writing within five days of the suspension. The Library Director or designee will review the patron's appeal, as well as Incident Reports and related documentation. The patron may also request an appointment with the Library Director or designee to discuss the suspension.
- 3. The suspension period may be terminated or shortened, or remain in place at the discretion of the Library Director or designee who will then inform the patron of the decision in writing.
- 4. The patron may appeal the decision of the Library Director or designee to the Library Board of Trustees via a written notice of appeal within ten days after the receipt of that decision. The notice of appeal must be sent to both the Library Director and the Library Board President, care of: Clifton Park–Halfmoon Public Library, 475 Moe Road, Clifton Park, NY 12065.
- 5. The Library Board of Trustees will review the appeal at its next regularly scheduled meeting. The patron will be provided with notice of the meeting date, and may appear in person. If the patron is a minor (under the age of 18), a parent or guardian must accompany the minor to the meeting.
- 6. The patron will be notified by letter of the decision of the Library Board of Trustees after they have reviewed the appeal. The suspension will remain in effect until this decision is made.
- 7. Any patron appealing a decision to the Library Board of Trustees shall be aware that the meetings of the Board of Trustees are, by law, open to the public. The Board's discussion and consideration of an appeal, including the underlying facts and any statements made by the appealing patron shall, generally, be done in a public forum. Consequently a patron should not have an expectation of privacy with regard to his or her appeal.

Responsibilities:

It is the responsibility of the Library Director or his/her designee to enforce this policy.

I've put plenty of additional thought into what happened last month.

I wrote that last email because I truly believed that you had taken the document that I sent you around October 2nd, and then tasked the IT guy with performing portions of the work written in that document.

Your responses were very telling that you were covering for your employee.

You had no idea you were lying to my face.

"We've been installing solid state drives in the computers for years..."

Nah. I mean, maybe you people have installed some SSD's in some of the computers, I'm not debating that at all.

What I'm debating is that I saw the guy who works there, coming into the computer lab, going from one machine to the next AFTER I wrote that document, and like, sent it to you. And, to add insult to injury, you called the Saratoga County Sheriffs Office on me on 10/3/2022 which I recorded...

There's a reason why I write a lot of documents about controversial subjects, and it is because people have a really hard time understanding when or where they need to take the initiative to ask more questions.

I'm going to expand upon what I talked about in that document Cassie

FightingEntropy/2022_1001-(CASSIE).pdf at main · mcc85s/FightingEntropy (github.com) in this email, because I would rather be seen as an INTELLECTUAL with a well-meaning purpose, than to be some haggard insult lobbing thug, who goes around (doing/saying) stuff that makes people feel uncomfortable.

That's not my objective, to intimidate or bully people...

...my objective is to educate people.

Up until the day you came to the library, I was in that computer lab on an almost daily basis. For several days, I saw some of the errors that were showing up on those computers. I am a Microsoft Certified Professional. I know how to resolve those errors. They were showing up because the drive was going bad, and that is what I literally told your employee...

I literally told the guy "Hey. I think those drives are going bad."

And he's like "Ok. Thanks."

The reason why the errors kept coming up, is because I had a lot of exposure to those specific errors in relation to Windows Update, when I managed the Computer Answers shop for about 3+ years.

Typically, when a system goes to perform an update, and it experiences some sort of issue after the update, or something is preventing the update from installing itself automatically, it is because the HARD DRIVE is going bad, and that is what I told your employee.

I'm not talking about the TALL guy with the glasses.

From all of my observations, that guy hasn't done anything remotely shady.

But, I don't judge people by their appearances alone, and I'm not going to write off the potential possibility that perhaps HE is the reason why they started installing the SSD's.

The guy that I'm talking about, is the guy who looks like he just goes into the server room, and watches YouTube videos all day. Maybe I'm wrong with that assessment, I haven't thought to open the door and determine what the hell that dude does all day. But- from what I have observed...? It does not look like he does anything remotely stressful or difficult, and he takes a really long time to do stuff. Wiping and reloading an operating system like Windows takes 15 minutes with the program I have been developing.

I talked about that in the document Cassie.

He took over 3 hours to replicate the hard drive on Lab #2 or Lab #3, and then he came in, and had like 2 hours left on Friday the 14th, and he like, decided to call it a day and just leave the machine open on the desk, for the entire weekend.

Now, I'm not YOU, but if I WERE you, I would've written that guy up for doing that. There's no excuse to be leaving machines open, needing service for the entire weekend, especially when installing Windows 10 from like a thumb drive takes about *checks watch* 10-15 minutes.

Those are all Intel Core i5-3500 desktops with like 16GB of RAM. It takes 10 minutes to install Windows 10. CASSIE may take additional time to prepare and shore up, however, uhThat dude who gets paid to work there...? He's really, really slow at what he does.

It's true that you don't have dozens of people bursting through the door to use the computer lab machines. So, there isn't an inherent reason why he can't just take (5) days to install Windows 10 on (10) machines... I actually talk about how someone could do that in the document CASSIE.

The fact that I had no issues with anybody at that library for the few months I went there, and did work every day. Then suddenly, your employee takes the "initiative" from the document I wrote, after YOU called the police on me.

I put "initiative" in air quotes, because I don't know what other word to use. Allow me to use a metaphor.

TYPICALLY, whenever I use the word "initiative"...?

I'm thinking about drawing up comparisons between myself, and Michaelangelo, painting the ceiling of the Sistine Chapel for like 7 years straight, until it was absolutely perfect.

But in that dude's specific case...?

I'm using "initiative" in air quotes to draw up a comparison between his work ethic, and the breathtaking quality that a preschooler might accomplish when he's like 4 years old, learning how to fingerpaint.

I am attempting to make this rather comedic, and detailed.

The reason being, I know that when people LOOK at me, they ASSUME that because I LOOK like I'm an idiot that would never notice something...? Well, to the people who casually do this, in their minds that must automatically mean that I MUST be an idiot who would never notice something so minor and miniscule. Butthat's where the cleverly written insults come in really handy.

Based on my observations, you've done very little to be considered worthy of being insulted, hence why I've decided to write this... perhaps this is a partial apology to some degree...? But, more specifically, because your demeanor when I met you, caused me to regret having sent that last email... because I could tell based on your responses, you had absolutely no idea nor were involved in what they did.

I merely speculated that as the case because I didn't give the document to anybody else, except you.

Regardless, SOME people may take a glance at the documents I write.

I've spent the last month since I've been at the library, making audio logs, and talking like a professor would. I am absolutely certain that I could be a teacher or a professor at a college or a university, because a lot of my rhetoric sounds a lot like Robert Sopolsky from Stanford University (among others).

The documents and the audio logs I've been writing and recording aren't exactly all FORMAL, because I've got a LOT of shit on my plate, and on that plate, are a long list of people in this community that have written me off repeatedly, over and over, just casually throwing me into a category of people I have no business being in. Oh, and someone decided to steal my laptop since I haven't been going to the library, and some of my hard drives.

Regardless, none of that is really any fault of yours.

All of this backstory is WHY I wrote the document to you, about some of my personal situations.

The way I could describe it is like this...

Dr. Richard Todd Loeber, Saratoga Hospital

Dr. Samuel Bastian, Saratoga County Mental Health

I have seen BOTH of these doctors here, and what I can tell you first hand, is that Dr. Samuel Bastian actually studies psychiatry, and actually earned his doctorate. Dr. Richard Todd Loeber commits this thing called

MEDICAL FRAUD, and doesn't provide proper evaluations of people, and likes to cut corners and rush diagnosis and stuff like that.

On one hand, guys like Richard Todd Loeber are plentiful... They got their doctorate at K-Mart, K-Mart doesn't actually have a school where they teach psychiatry...? But I am absolutely convinced that is exactly where this dude got his doctorate. It makes perfect sense. The man rushed his diagnosis and like, has multiple OTHER doctors that he sends packets of information which has predated forms and signatures written on them, so that he can casually misdiagnose people at Saratoga Hospital on a daily basis. He drives around in a 2017 Blue Audi S7, and I could even give you the VIN number and the license plate of the vehicle if you really wanna know.

I do not like Richard Todd Loeber, I am absolutely convinced that he is a scam artist doctor.

On the OTHER hand, Dr. Samuel Bastian, is an actual doctor that studies psychiatry, who either currently or formerly directed the Four Winds hospital that my son Michael C. Cook Jr. was admitted to back in February 2017. He was diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder and Attention Deficeit Hyperactivity Disorder, and his diagnosis led to my diagnosis finally being taken seriously by the doctors I talked to about my concerns for like, DECADES.

Yeah, so, as soon as my SON was diagnosed with those conditions, I was able to be diagnosed by someone that has a doctorate to study medicine. What I'm saying is that a lot of doctors (and people) are LAZY.

My mother never had me tested for these conditions.

My father was murdered when I was 10 years old.

I was victimized by kids at the Shenendehowa Central School district where I attended for 13 years. I was molested by an older kid when I was 7 years old, who I wound up assaulting with a baseball bat when I was 17, because he spent an entire summer breaking into my house (4) times that my mother and I called to report the break ins to the Saratoga County Sheriff's Office. They did nothing to investigate or question this dude.

Anyway, the notion I'm alluding to here, is that people really like to treat me like I'm an idiot and that I don't know what's happening. But that's because I know when people are bullshitting me, and I've had this capability for a very long time.

Samuel Bastian gave me a test for about 3 hours and had me fill out a questionnaire, and it took about 3+ weeks for him to get the results back and to confirm the assessment and send the results to Paul Pelagalli.

The last question that Samuel Bastian asked me during the evaluation was:

"Have you always sounded this intelligent when you talk...?"

The answer is no.

This entire email, I'm the one writing every word, I'm not using like Grammarly, or like having to use the word suggestions in order to write with my specific style of writing.

I could write like this for hours a day, and I could probably get paid a lot of money to do this, or to teach people... However...? Uh- I need to find some people that VALUE my intelligence and my capabilities, because as far as I can tell, a lot of people are really stupid, and they think that I am insane.

Maybe I am, and I just write stuff really eloquently and well thought out, and BECAUSE I write as well as I do...? Some people like most of the police at the Saratoga County Sheriffs Office, they can only really get through like (2) full sentences, before they get really flustered and overwhelmed by my documents, writing style, and vocabulary, and... THAT is when they do what Michael Zurlo does... "Holy shit dude. I ... need a 1) juice box...? And, a 2) 5 hour nap."

Effectively, what I'm saying is that Michael Zurlo is pretty fucking lazy.

I'm not gonna go around insulting all of the police that work at SCSO or the NYSP. However, they typically rely on what their coworkers write or document and THEY MAKE NO EFFORT TO VALIDATE WHAT THOSE COWORKERS SAY/DO.

People in society ALSO do this.

You have literally done this. If I see the behavior ONCE...? I'm not going to say/write negative things in every corner, nook, and cranny I can find, and say "Yeah, director of the library ... not a huge fan, lemme tell ya..."

However, if I were to see recurring behaviors where you're acting in the same exact way that you did when you came into the computer lab, and you were literally covering for your IT guy without even knowing what the hell you were saying...?

The police do that too.

The doctors do that too.

The lawyers do that too.

A lot of people in our society do this, where they KNOW somebody who REALLY knows SOMETHING... and THAT means, that who they know trumps what I know, and that's all there is to it, in their eyes.

Uh- the last sentence is my take on reverse psychology.

I'm not going around saying that I'm the smartest dude who ever lived, and that what I know is the best, or that I'm the best at everything that anybody could be really good at...? Cause that would be pretty stupid...

However, when I go around being CONFIDENT in what I know...?

It actually pisses some people off. Maybe the situation changes from scenario to scenario, maybe people are pissed off by my intelligence, but they're just afraid of it. Or, they'll misinterpret things I say because they don't realize how interwoven my reverse psychology is.

Simply put, in this video https://youtu.be/HT4p28bRhqc, I said this to my children: When all (4) corners of a rhombus are a PERFECT 90 degrees...? That rhombus is ALSO a square.

That means that only in a SINGLE condition, is a rhombus the same thing as a square. And, most people in society don't realize how critical that fact truly is. Maybe I'm generalizing that to a large degree, who knows. I have to make SOME speculations or even assumptions in some cases, that most people really don't give a rats ass about whether something FACTUALLY occurred, or whether it NON-FACTUALLY occurred (which means that it did not occur).

That's how the police get down, sometimes.

Sometimes they don't really CARE about whether they have EVIDENCE of a CRIME having been committed...? They can just arrest someone without it, OR, they can actually IGNORE the EXISTENCE of evidence such as an AUDIO RECORDING.

Some people may try to argue with me "YEAH RIGHT, DUDE, THE POLICE DON'T JUST ARREST PEOPLE THAT NEVER COMMITTED A CRIME OR WHATEVER~!"

Yes, they most certainly do. And, they do this a lot.

They don't really CARE if they have to arrest someone that didn't commit a crime, especially if someone is throwing them a really nice stack of cash, to:

- 1) shut the hell up, and
- 2) look the other way.

That's why I wrote about John Hoffman, Bruce Tanski, Eric Catricala, and Paul/Peter Amato, the former Town of Halfmoon Supervisor who was implicated in a conspiracy to commit bank fraud through my former employer, KeyCorp.

I don't typically write long winded emails to people like this one right here, however, I think that you deserve an apology for the email I sent last month.

It's really not my cup of tea. But I also don't really care for the idea of feeling like someone took some ideas I had, and then just ya know, thought nothing of mislabeling me like people continually do.

That's what the NYSP and SCSO did to me on June 28th, 2022.

I've been spending a LONG TIME at that library updating my BOOK, and though I'm not gonna win a Pulitzer prize for my book writing, the book that I was writing THAT DAY, is the REAL reason why the police arrested me on June 28th, 2022.

Why was I arrested that day and why have I been going to the library...?

Uh- because my mother and I kept having these arguments where I explain to her what the definition of the word "Evidence" is. She doesn't really care. She cares about that word if she's playing SCRABBLE, or whatever... but when it comes to looking at stuff in order to have her facts straight...? She is about as fucking lazy as anybody's mother could ever be. Especially one that had her husband killed when her child was 10 years old.

I do not hate my mother...? But- I really do think she has a serious psychological condition, and I think that is the REAL reason why so many people just like to play this game with me where they treat me as a black sheep or a scapegoat.

Ya know...?

This email should exhibit very clearly, that I'm a sophisticated sounding, intelligent person, I didn't spend all day writing this...? I just know how to write stuff.

Really, I think I've spent less than 40 minutes writing up this email.

I write a lot.

Whether it's on Facebook, or in the word editor, or in the programs I use to write my programs... I write a lot of material. I can also express these trains of thought VERBALLY as I do in my many, many audio logs.

That's like 9 hours of content right there.

Some of the material is OFFENSIVE, but that's because I've been working at this like famous comedian George Carlin. The English language is rather complex, and there's nothing particularly evil about the words themselves.

However, uh- expressing some of these thoughts is a lot like having to fart. You let the thought/fart out...? You feel better, and then a weight is lifted off of your shoulders. That's why the FIRST AMENDMENT, exists. You know, these school shootings and stuff, they happen because our society has this moronic notion: "If you have nothing nice to say...? Don't say anything at all." Because it sorta bleeds right into "See no evil, Hear no evil, Speak no evil." The evil is there.

It's pretty stupid, actually.

It's one thing if someone has a disposition and has a hard time thinking of something to say, but it's a totally separate matter when people have PLENTY of things to say, and yet they just choose not to. Why...? Because maybe it boils down to SOCIETAL EXPECTATIONS.

Societal expectations are pretty ridiculous sometimes.

Sometimes they're fine. I'm not going to walk into the library and say stuff like "Fuck everybody, everybody sucks, you're all really fuckin' lame~!"

Nah. Not gonna go that. It's never been a thought on my mind, to act on.

However, there's some PHILOSOPHY behind the notion of there being a SPECTRUM between "Where would it be considered reprehensible to say those things, and where would it be considered commendable to say those things...?"

That's what philosophy is all about.

That's why I write and record as often as I do.

Mainly because, uh- when I try to teach some dude who worked at a computer shop for a lot of years BEFORE I worked there... but, didn't know how to do simple basic stuff that would bring in a lot more profit...? Like I taught him to do within my first 6 months...? Well, I'm like, teaching him how to make more money. Some guy. Worked there for like, years. Once I started working there...? I taught him some stuff that made the company more money.

And what I get in return for doing that, is a middle finger to the face...

"Thanks for helping us make more money and upgrading everything about the business. Now, fuck off." - Computer Answers

People don't knowingly SAY those words, right...? However, their ACTIONS certainly do. ACTIONS SPEAK LOUDER THAN WORDS.

Side stepping all of that.

As for some of my audio logs or documents...?

Most people in society don't understand stuff like quantum physics, application development, psychology, mathematics, astrophysics, etc. If you try to talk to people in every day life about these things...? They may need a juice box and a nap, within like, the first couple sentences.

I'm not saying that juice boxes and naps aren't like, bad or anything.

I will occasionally drink a juice box, and take a nap if I feel like it.

It's just, not something I ever think to do after reading (2) sentences of what somebody wrote.

So, I have to ask myself some questions.

If my MOTHER was never very SUPPORTIVE in respect to my INTELLIGENCE and what I can do with a COMPUTER, or a DOCUMENT, or an AUDIO RECORDING, or some of my VIDEOS...? And, my FATHER was brutally MURDERED when I was a CHILD...?

Who the hell is supposed to support anything that I do ...?

I'll tell ya.

Nobody, that's who.

I really don't like the idea of accepting HANDOUTS, I would really prefer to be earning my own income and ya know, teaching people what I know. The reason why I am not already doing that, is because... there's actually a rather large number of morons here in the town of Clifton Park, NY.

Sometimes I ask myself, "If I had to GUESS, what percentage of people are between an IQ of 80 to 120... what would that percentage be...?"

Well, I'd say about 95%.

About 5% of the people in this town have an IQ somewhere above 120 and no greater than 160.

Maybe about 1% of the population here in town, or even less, has an IQ of over 160.

I could be wrong...? I'm not saying those are hard numbers. I'm just trying to figure out a way to understand with some level of certainty, why I go around saying stuff to people, and it is constantly mislabeled.

I think it all comes down to the way that I walk.

Maybe, when people see me walk the way that I do, they start to think:

Person[1]: Wow, there's some dude, lookin' like he's goin' somewhere...

Person[2]: *looks* Wow. Sure looks like that IS some dude, goin' somewhere.

Person[1]: Well... I wonder where he's goin'.

Person[2]: He's probably goin' somewhere real important with the WAY that he's walkin'...

Person[1]: Yeah, that's precisely what I was thinking...

Person[2]: Look at the way he moves his feet...

Person[1]: It's as if he's doing it all himself... All that walkin' and stuff he's doin.

Person[2]: Yeh dude. He does seem to be walking all on his own.

Person[1]: That stride of his... it's commendable.

Person[2]: Respectable.

Person[1]: *Turns and looks at person[2]* You know what this means, right...?

Person[2]: ...what...?

Person[1]: That dude right there, he's taking the act of walking with confidence, to new heights.

Person[2]: Yeh. That much is clearly able to be seen...

Person[1]: You know what ELSE that means, right...?

Person[2]: What else does it mean...?

Person[1]: It means... he's on the friggen war path, dude.

Person[2]: ...he is...?

Person[1]: Yep. Dude walkin' like him...? That's some straight-up, war-path walkin' right there, dude.

Person[2]: How do you figure...?

Person[1]: I mean, just LOOK at him... That mean look in his eye...

Person[2]: ...mean look in his eye...?

Person[1]: Yeh. Dude looks like he was raised by wolves. A pack of hungry lions, even... He's just doin' his own thing.

Person[2]: That he is, Person[1]. That he is...

Person[1]: I hope that dude gets to where he's goin, and that's that.

Person[2]: You know, we've just spent the last like, couple minutes talking about the way that dude's walkin...

Person[1]: Yeh, I know. Such a confident, high falutin' walk bravado right there, dude. I envy that dude...

Person[2]: Yeah well, he's still walkin'.

Person[1]: I wonder how much walkin' he's got left before him...

Person[2]: Heh. Probably miles and miles.

Person[1]: *long hard stare* Probably at least a 20 mile walk he's makin'.

Person[2]: ...how do you figure, 20 miles...?

Person[1]: Heh. How do I figure 20 miles...?

Person[2]: Yeh, how do you figure he's got like a 20 mile walk ahead of him...?

Person[1]: I mean, look at him, dude. Look at that mean look in his eye, you're tellin' me you see the way that dude is walkin' and the look in his eye, and you don't think he's goin' on AT LEAST, a 20 mile walk...?

Person[2]: I... dunno dude. I'm just sayin', how could you tell THAT, just by lookin' at the WAY he walks...?

Person[1]: *shakes head* I dunno, pal. But- the road ahead for that guy looks like it might be treacherous... dangerous.

Person[2]: I can see that, for sure.

So, that's how I can write dialog. It's a lot like the dialog on Seinfeld, or Curb Your Enthusiasm, or like, a lot of other comic plots and such. Whenever I watch TV these days, most of the content on the television seems rather fake and brittle.

Anyway, the dialog above I found a way to segue into this chunk of content below. As for the things I write, sometimes they ARE more focused and comedic... sometimes I really put a lot of thought into insulting somebody, cobbling together skits like that one up above, only to poke fun at certain people. I'm not going to do that unless I feel it is warranted, and even if it IS warranted, I'm going to get bored of the subject at some point.

When I do NOT get bored of a particular subject at all, then I will continually expand upon it. But I'll tell you a subject that I could spend the rest of my life writing about, such as when people lie to me, and think nothing of it.

When people casually lie right to my face, they rarely ever realize that I know damn well I'm being lied to, and depending on the severity of the lie I'm being told, uh- that's when I start to whip out the thuggish comments like "Sounds like somebody could use a fresh pair of broken legs..."

I'm not gonna think of something that intense if the weight of the lie being told isn't very heavy at all. For instance, a director of a library casually lying to me, about something that she had no idea she was lying about.

If anything, the WAY that she was lying to me, told me a LOT about her character. What it told me, was that she may be someone who has been pushed around a fair amount in HER lifetime, but also, she will take people at their word AHEAD of time, in order to defend some of her coworkers.

However, when I understood what exactly I was dealing with, I actually deeply regretted having sent the original email. Because, there's no way about it, I made an assumption. But- so did she.

As for the incident, I really don't care about the money.

I've been homeless ever since June 28th, 2022.

I'm not looking to work at some dead end job where I'm not capitalizing or expanding upon the work I've been doing. If I'm gonna work somewhere, it's going to be somewhere where I will be a valuable asset to an organization, and it won't actually FEEL like I'm doing WORK, because the WORK that I do, will be me continuing to be myself, as I was as I wrote this particular email.

The sad reality, is that our society will openly praise guys like William Shakespeare, but when it comes to understanding some of his rhetoric or motiviations for writing the stories that he did...? People in our current society think that shit is quite insane.

To many people, intelligence = insanity. They appear to be virtually identical. This isn't a one-size-fits-all scenario here.

Much how the RHOMBUS with (4) perfect 90 degree angles is ALSO a SQUARE...? Someone of an intelligence such as myself, is going to APPEAR to be quite insane, and that's just because society has a lot of fucking problems.

Some people don't know HOW to SOLVE or ADDRESS those problems, either.

I can tell you that SOLVING as well as ADDRESSING those problems, is as simple as knowing when people are lying to you, AND, caring about having your facts straight.

In elementary school, the schools teach the kids these fun little games like "hot potato", or "telephone". These games do a lot to teach individuals about how a GROUP of people 1) think, and 2) relay information.

In Musical Chairs or Hot Potato, it is a metaphor for people with RESOURCES.

Appeal Procedures

Any patron suspended for more than one day may appeal the suspension by:

- 1. Patrons suspended for more than one day can contact the Library Director in writing, within five days of the suspension. The Library Director or designee will consult with staff, review the Incident Reports and related documentation and any written information provided by the patron. The patron may also schedule an appointment with the Library Director or designee to discuss the suspension.
- 2. After reviewing information and/or meeting with the patron, the suspension period may be terminated or shortened or the suspension may remain in place. The Library Director will inform the patron of the decision in writing.
- 3. The patron may appeal the determination of the Library Director to the Library Board of Trustees via a written notice of appeal within 10 days after receipt of the Library Director's determination. The notice of appeal must be sent to both the Library Director and the Library Board President, care of Clifton Park-Halfmoon Public Library, 475 Moe Road, Clifton Park, NY 12065.
- 4. The Library Board of Trustees will review the suspension at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Library Board. The patron will be provided with notice of the meeting date. A parent or guardian must accompany a minor (under the age of 18) to the meeting.
- 5. The Library Board of Trustees will hear the appeal and will vote to uphold or dismiss the suspension. The patron will be notified by letter of the decision of the Library Board of Trustees. The suspension will be in effect until this vote is taken.

This morning IT staff at the Library informed me that Michael Cook had attempted to access the Library's network. A network cable was found attached to the computer Mr. Cook has been using regularly and there was an error on that machine. (Our security on the public network prevents anyone from connecting their personal computer) Because of this attempt to access our network, I informed Mr. Cook that he is banned from the Library again.

The discussion with Mr. Cook took place outside the Library entrance just before we opened at 9am. He started recording me and was agitated about the fact that I was banning him from the Library, as he didn't feel he had violated any policies. I didn't feel threatened by Mr. Cook, but he did become quite loud and I had a difficult time disengaging from the conversation. Staff called 911, and a State Police officer and several Sheriff's deputies arrived, but by that time Mr. Cook had left the library properly.

Mr. Cook asked for information about appealing my decision, and I informed him of the next Board Meeting date and time. I also told him that trustees can be contacted via email on our website.

I asked the police officers if Mr. Cook had ever become physically violent, and they said they had no knowledge of any issues of that nature.

I have emailed the letter and appeal procedures to Mr. Cook as we don't have a current mailing address.

I expect that he will post the video of our discussion on his social media sites.

Our guards and staff have been informed of the suspension.
