



Digital Newspapers

Access digital newspapers on your computer or handheld device

YOU WILL NEED

- Requires a Clifton Park-Halfmoon Public Library card for access
- A WiFi connection

1. START AT THE LIBRARY'S HOMEPAGE - CPHLIBRARY.ORG

- Click **Research**. [If using a handheld device, tap **Menu**, then tap **Research**.]
- Click or tap **Newspapers**.
- Scroll to the title you want to read.
- Click or tap **Access Now** under the title, and enter your library card number.

2. AVAILABLE TITLES

- **Access World News with NewsBank** includes thousands of titles from around the world. To see a full title list click **A-Z Source List** at the top of the page after you click Access Now. To see the paper as it is in print, look for Format "Image."
- The **Daily Gazette** looks just like the print version if you select the "Image" Format link.
- **Gale OneFile: News** is text-only news from a variety of sources locally, regionally, and nationally.
- **New York Post** looks just like the print version if you select the "Image" Format link.
- **The New York Times**
 - There are two listings for the **New York Times**. One is for *inside* Library use, while the other is for *outside* Library use.
 - Account creation is required the first time you use WSJ. After the account is created you should **Sign In** NOT Create an Account
 - View the **short** video **tutorial** for some quick tips.
 - Access is for 24 hours
 - To renew access, repeat the process **cphlibrary.org > Research > Newspapers**, etc.
- The **Times Union** looks just like the print version if you select the "Image" Format link.
- **USA Today**, the most popular newspaper in the US by circulation, is available in "Image" Format.
- **Wall Street Journal**
 - Account creation is required the first time you use WSJ. After the account is created you should **Sign In** NOT Create an Account.
 - Access is for 72 hours
 - To renew access, repeat the process **cphlibrary.org > Research > Newspapers**, etc.
